#### COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

**Early Childhood Music** Very young children are in a musical development stage known as preparatory audiation. Teachers will learn how to recognize a child's developmental stage, to provide appropriate informal music guidance, and to develop a repertoire of songs, chants, and activities appropriate for early childhood music. **Faculty:** Anna Preston and Natasha Sigmund.

**Instrumental Music** The course is based on music learning theory, audiation, and beginning instrumental or piano instruction. Teaching/learning experiences will focus on assisting students to learn two instruments – the audiation instrument (the instrument in the mind) and the executive instrument (the physical instrument). Participants will learn how to help students learn to sing, chant, move, and play instruments in tune, rhythmically, and with consistent tempo. **Faculty:** Richard Grunow and Kathy Liperote.

**Elementary General Music** Teachers will learn how to assess a child's developmental and stabilized music aptitude, deliver classroom and learning sequence activities to assist music learning, and teach children how to audiate. Topics will include singing, chanting, movement, dance, lesson plan development and music learning theory. **Faculty:** Beth Bolton and Heather Kirby.
