

In this regard, in March 2000 and in December 2006 he conducted the symphonic musical tale "Peter and the Wolf" by S. Prokovief with Elio Pandolfi (famous Italian actor) as narrator and the opera "The Carnival of the Animals" by C. Saint-Saens.

He also edited the staging and conducting of a major version of the opera "Prima la Musica, poi le Parole" by Antonio Salieri, staged at the Teatro "Salieri" Legnago in 2002, as guest conductor of the "Festival Salieri" and the running in the course of a project "Along the river, on the Clitunno musical paths" of the Water Music" G.F.Haendel, August 2002. 
